Barbara Elizabeth Kirk Muncy departed her earthly home on Monday, January 9, 2017 following a long, hard fought battle with multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's and Alzheimer disease.

Barbara was born on April 20, 1944 to the late Columbia Ferrell Kirk and Paul Kirk. She is also preceded in death by her maternal grandparents, Christopher and Cora Ferrell and a brother whom she loved and cherished, Paul Kirk Jr. and paternal grandparents, Floyd, Josephine and Nora Kirk.

Barbara is survived by her loving husband of 53 years, Bobby Muncy, a son, Bobby Muncy and wife, Vanessa of Gallipolis, Ohio, a daughter, Rhonda Muncy-Little and husband, Ronnie of Lovely, Kentucky. She also had two grandsons, who she adored, Cameron Lewis Muncy and fiance, Brittany Hively and Colby Muncy.

Barbara also had a sister, Elsie Mills of Louisa, Kentucky who was a devoted sister and caregiver.

Barbara graduated from Kermit High School. She was a beautician but spent most of her career as a secretary for Kermit Lumbar Company and Kirk trucking.

Barbara was a member of the Inez Church of Christ. She treasured her spiritual family. She spent countless hours doing volunteer work before her health declined. She worked with Champions Against Drugs, developed a MS Support Group in Eastern Kentucky which held meetings and provided a newsletter for others suffering with MS and their families. She coordinated several MS walks and was a member of the National MS Society. She also did volunteer efforts for the Ronald McDonald House. She also served on the Martin County Library Board.

Funeral services will be held at the Inez Church of Christ on Friday, January 13, 2017 at 1:00pm with James Russell Maynard officiating. Burial will follow at the Mt.
