Benjamin Harrison Jude, 84 of Kermit, West Virginia left this earthly home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, January 20th. Harrison was born on June 14, 1936 in Chattaroy, West Virginia to the late John Jude and Nora Cain Jude. Harrison was preceded in death by his sisters Anna Mae Huke and Rebecca Vanover, his brothers John David Jude and James Jude and his special nephew David Jude.
