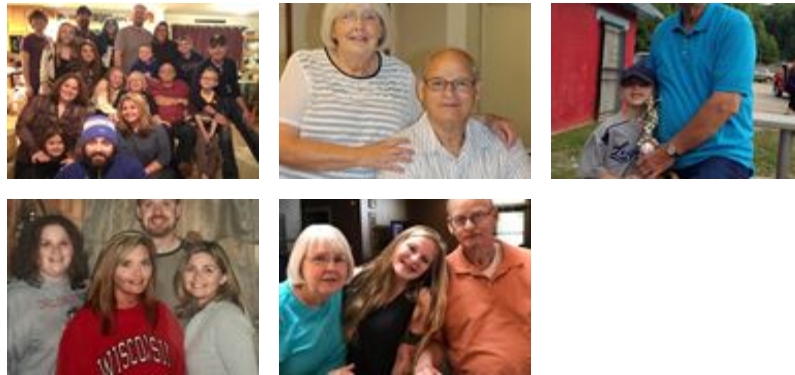

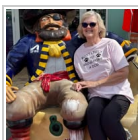

We spent days and days digging a 40 foot ditch about 5 foot deep. I don't know if I have complained more than that in my entire life.

One thing about Bill, he loved his kids and his grandkids more than anything and by default loved me and Blake as well.

Anyways, Bill will be missed by us all. Prayers for my second family as the impacts of his life on us are celebrated this one last time.
