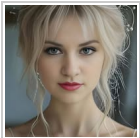
After hearing this lady's voice on FB, I looked her up to see what church she attended. I was saddened to see she had passed, but so happy her,

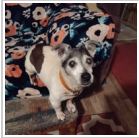
