



## Jack Harry Horn

December 8, 1944 - March 18, 2018

Jack Harry Horn, born December 8, 1944, with his twin sister, Anna Laura Horn, passed into God's grace after a brief illness on March 18, 2018.

Jack was a resident of Inez, Martin County, Kentucky for his entire life. He is survived by his wife Gladys Copley Horn, and two children, Jackie Leigh Horn, Esq. (C. Andrew Stephens) of Nicholasville, and Dr. Todd Lindsey Horn (Melinda) of Somerset. Jack and Gladys were high school sweethearts who married on August 10, 1968 and enjoyed 49 years of marriage.

Also surviving Jack are his five wonderful grandchildren, Andrew William Holt, Allison Leigh Holt, Ashton Blake Holt, Jackson Chase Horn and Lindsey Caroline Horn along with three siblings, Anna Parsley, Evertte Horn Jr. and Beuford Horn.

Jack is preceded in death by his parents, Everette and Clara Mills Horn and two siblings, Euladean Jennings and Ella Mae Mollette.

Jack graduated from Inez High School in 1963, Berea College in 1967, and the University of Kentucky College of Law in 1970. After graduating from Law School, Jack enlisted in the U.S. Army at Fort Knox, Kentucky and Fort Polk, Louisiana. He became and awarded Drill Sergeant and was honorably discharged in 1974. After his army service, Jack returned to Inez to open his law practice. Jack served his community over a 46 year period in many capacities – in private practice, as Trial Commissioner, Domestic Relations Commissioner, Assistant County Attorney, and lastly as the elected Circuit Court Clerk of Martin County until his retirement in December 2016.

Jack was proud to walk to work each and every day and greeted his friends on the streets of Inez with a smile and a happy, upbeat, positive manner. Jack never knew a stranger.

Jack was an active member of the Marion Hale Masonic Lodge #672 in 1971. Jack represented the Lodge as the Pass Master. He was District Deputy Grand Master of Murfield Lodge #882 and a member of The Ted Adams Lodge of Research, #998. He was also a Shriner at El Hasha Shriners in Ashland, Kentucky.

Jack had a quiet, respectful nature and as he commanded his troops in the army with a reserve authority, he never had a bad word to speak to anyone. Jack worshipped Jackie and Todd and his five grandchildren. He was the perfect grandparent; he loved them, guided them, took care of them and participated in their upbringing on a daily basis. His grandchildren were his pride and joy.

Jack was a patriot and an American, a husband, father, grandfather and a simply decent soul who will be missed by all.

Funeral services will be held at the Callaham Funeral Home in Inez, Kentucky on Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 1:00pm with Kevin Davis officiating. Burial will follow at the Greenlawn Cemetery in Louisa, Kentucky. Friends may visit at the funeral home on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 from 6:00-8:00pm.
