Juanita Justice, 97, passed peacefully at her home in Inez, Kentucky, on September 9, 2024. She was born on September 28, 1926, in Hardy, Kentucky to the late Lawrence Justice and Edith Fitzpatrick Justice. In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her brothers, Albert Eli “Bo” Justice and John Douglas Justice. She leaves behind many beloved cousins, friends, and special caretakers who were with her through her illness.

A graduate of Inez High School, Class of 1944, Juanita moved to Columbus, Ohio to pursue a career. After working in Columbus for several years, she returned to Inez to accept a position with Inez Deposit Bank to be closer to her family. Juanita rose to Vice President of the bank before retiring after 25 years of service.
