Jr. loved his family and his Lord. He enjoyed laughing, loving, and living life with Carol, felt blessed to have Wesley and Jennifer, and always said, "I love you!" and "We need to trust in the Lord." His four grandsons gave him great joy and he treasured every moment spent with them. He has always been extremely close with his siblings and enjoyed living life with each of them. Jr. truly lived out the two commandments found in Scripture; "...Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind," and "...Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself" (Mathew 22:37-39).
