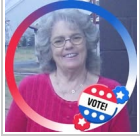

Troy checked the house and found a box with unopened bills and statements and we knew you were headed for trouble. Another family member had offered to help you with them and you said you did not need any help. At that time, maybe you did not. Now you certainly did. I just told you the situation and that you needed help. You agreed to let me, so I did. We got everything fixed up and you kept me as your secretary (as you called me) You did not want to go to the Doctors or hospital, but you needed to, and you did go and did every test they wanted done. You hated all the needles, but submitted to them. I told you once that you were a good patient. You said "I hope so" I said "you are". I wanted you to know that. I look back now with thankfulness and almost amazement at how well you faced your battles. Your last 51 or so days were horrific. Vomiting every day except the last 4 or 5, and in the beginning, many times a day. Still no complaints. One day after a very hard time you said "LORDY, LORDY. I said "LORDY, LORDY, I reckon!! You told Troy and others you loved Jesus and you were all right, You and Him were good buddies. Your family wants everyone to know how much we appreciate their prayers, their kind words, flowers, being with us for the viewing and funeral. The singers:Bro. George and Sis Brooke Alley, Sis.
